# CAR15/M4 Buttstock Wrench Safety Instructions

## Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the CAR15/M4 Buttstock Wrench by Brownells. This tool is designed to assist in the installation and removal of collapsible carbine buttstocks. To ensure safe and effective use, please read and follow the safety instructions outlined in this guide.

- If necessary, utilize the pry blade/screwdriver feature for additional leverage.
- For torque applications, insert a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square drive tool into the designated opening for proper torque adjustment.

### 3. PostUse:

- After completing your task, clean the wrench to remove any debris or residue.
- Store the wrench in a safe and dry location, preferably hanging on a pegboard using the hole in the handle.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the wrench responsibly by following local waste management regulations.
- If the wrench is damaged beyond repair, consider recycling the metal components where possible.
