Safety Instruction Guide for BARREL/RECEIVER DIES

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the BARREL/RECEIVER DIES for the Remington 700. This product is designed to clean and chase dinged or imperfect threads, making it an essential tool for any rebarreling job.
