We found too, that we could feel tight spots during honing and spend extra time on them until they were evened out. On new barrels, the Fine hone by itself will bring the factory finish up to a beautiful, mirror-bright finish that's a real customer pleaser. Easy to use: chuck in a variable speed electric drill; wet the hone with Flex Hone® oil; start the drill and insert the hone into the barrel from the breech end (if possible). As it cuts, a slurry of abrasive and oil develops to help speed the cutting action. Flex Hone® available (shown below) in sets and individual hones for 10, 12, 16 and 20 gauge barrels as well as .410 bore. Also, special-sized hones for 10, 12, 16, 20 gauge chambers and .410 bore. Instructions walk you through the steps for a perfect job. (You MUST use Flex Hone® oil - all other oils will destroy the abrasive "balls" and void our guarantee!) 750 RPM MAX. Avoid excess pressure. - Chuck the Flex Hone® into the variable speed electric drill.
- Wet the hone with Flex Hone® oil before use.
- Insert the hone into the barrel from the breech end (if possible).
- Start the drill and allow the hone to rotate.
- As the hone cuts, a slurry of abrasive and oil will develop to assist in the polishing process.
- For used barrels, first use the MediumCoarse hone, followed by the Fine hone for optimal results.
- For new barrels, the Fine hone alone will achieve a mirrorbright finish.

3. PostUse:

- After honing, run a clean patch through the barrel to remove any residue.
- Inspect the barrel for a smooth and polished finish.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any used Flex Hone® oil according to local regulations.
- Dispose of the product responsibly; check with local waste management authorities for proper disposal methods.
