Quickly Draws Excess Oil Out Of Gun Stocks

Simple paint-it-on, brush-it-off process literally draws soaked-in grease and oils out of any oil-finished or oil-soaked gun stock. Especially useful on military stocks. Same method as described in the traditional gunsmithing books and just as effective now as then. Just make a thin paste of Whiting and methanol or TCE, acetone, or toluene and paint it onto the stock, then brush it off after it dries and darkens with oil. Warming gently speeds process. Repeat if needed; raise dents, sand and finish as usual.

Safety Instruction Guide for OLD FASHIONED WHITING

Introduction

Thank you for choosing OLD FASHIONED WHITING from BROWNELLS. This product is designed for the effective removal of grease and oils from oilfinished or oilsoaked gun stocks. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure safe use of all nonfood products, including OLD FASHIONED WHITING.
- Be aware of risks associated with chemicals and follow safety precautions.

Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- Do not mix OLD FASHIONED WHITING with other chemicals unless specified in the instructions.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation:

- Ensure the gun stock is clean and dry before application.
- Gather materials: OLD FASHIONED WHITING, methanol or TCE, acetone, or toluene, and a brush.

2. Mixing:

- Create a thin paste by mixing OLD FASHIONED WHITING with your chosen solvent.
- The consistency should be thick enough to adhere to the surface but not runny.

3. Application:

- Apply the paste evenly onto the affected areas of the gun stock using a brush.
- Ensure full coverage of the area to maximize effectiveness.

4. Drying:

- Allow the paste to dry completely. The drying time may vary based on environmental conditions.
- The paste will darken as it absorbs oils and grease.

5. Removal:

- Once dry, brush off the paste gently.

- Repeat the process if necessary to achieve desired results.

6. Finishing:

- After the final application and removal, you may raise dents, sand, and finish the stock as usual.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any unused product and empty containers in accordance with local regulations.
