Introduction

Thank you for choosing the DOUBLETUFF™ BORE BRUSH. This product is designed to provide effective cleaning for your shotgun bores. To ensure safe and effective use, please read and follow these safety instructions carefully.

- For Rifle Brushes: Ensure you are using the correct thread type (832 for standard rifles, 1032 for .54 and .58 caliber rifles).
- For Pistol Brushes: Attach using the 832 male threads.

3. Using the Bore Brush

- Insert the bore brush into the bore of the firearm.
- Push the brush through the bore with a firm but controlled motion.
- Repeat as necessary to remove stubborn deposits, ensuring to clean in both directions if needed.
- After use, clean the bore brush with solvent and allow it to dry.

4. PostCleaning

- Inspect the bore brush for any damage after use.
- Store the bore brush in a cool, dry place.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn bore brushes in accordance with local regulations for hazardous waste.
- Do not dispose of the bore brush in regular household waste if it is damaged.
