- For Pistol Brushes:

- Attach using the 832 male thread.

- Rotate the brush while pushing it through the bore to effectively remove carbon deposits and other debris.
- Repeat as necessary until the bore is clean.
- After use, remove the bore brush and clean it according to the manufacturer's instructions.
