

Introduction

- Pistol Brushes: 832 male threads
- Shotgun Brushes: 5/16"27 male threads

• Usage:

- Insert the bore brush into the bore of the firearm.
- Rotate the cleaning rod gently while pushing the brush through the bore.
- Pull the brush back out of the bore, ensuring not to scratch the interior.
- Repeat the process as necessary to remove stubborn carbon deposits.
- Clean the bore brush after use to maintain its effectiveness.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the bore brush in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the bore brush in regular household waste if it is damaged or worn.
