Introduction

Thank you for choosing the DOUBLETUFF™ Bore Brush. This product is designed to provide effective cleaning for your firearms. To ensure your safety and the optimal performance of the brush, please read and follow these safety instructions carefully.

2. Apply a suitable cleaning solvent to the bore brush.
3. Insert the bore brush into the firearm's bore.
4. Gently push the bore brush through the bore using a straight motion.
5. Pull the bore brush back out and repeat as necessary, applying more solvent if needed.
6. After cleaning, remove the bore brush and clean the firearm according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the bore brush in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the bore brush in regular household waste if it is damaged or contaminated with hazardous materials.
