

DOUBLETUFF™ BORE BRUSH SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the DOUBLETUFF™ BORE BRUSH. This product is designed to help you maintain the cleanliness and performance of your firearms. To ensure safe and effective use, please read and follow these safety instructions carefully.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always use the bore brush in a wellventilated area.
