## Introduction

It contains important information regarding product safety, usage precautions, and disposal methods, in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

## General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the DOUBLETUFF™ BORE BRUSH is used only for its intended purpose of cleaning firearm bores.
- Always handle firearms in a safe manner. Keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction at all times.

- For rifle brushes, use an 832 male thread for standard rifles. Note that .54 and .58 caliber rifles require a 1032 male thread.
- For pistol brushes, use an 832 male thread.
- For shotgun brushes, use a 5/16"27 male thread.

- Apply a small amount of cleaning solvent to the bristles of the bore brush.
- Insert the brush into the firearm bore and push it through gently, using a steady motion.
- Pull the brush back out of the bore, cleaning away any debris.

- Repeat the process as necessary until the bore is clean.
- After cleaning, ensure that the bore is free of any cleaning solvent or debris.

#### **4. PostUsage:**

- Clean the bore brush after use to maintain its effectiveness and longevity.
- Store the bore brush in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
