3. **Apply Cleaning Solvent:** Dampen the mop with an appropriate cleaning solvent or oil. Avoid soaking it to prevent excessive dripping.

5. **Clean the Bore:** Pull the mop through the bore in a single, smooth motion. Repeat as necessary, using additional solvent as needed.
