Lightweight, aluminum clamp locks barrel and extended magazine tube together to form a rigid, rock-solid assembly. Can be used as a tactical light mount: install a 1" diameter light in one side of the clamp and secure the other side to the barrel or magazine. Left- and right-side sling swivel sockets accept standard pushbutton swivels. Two steel Allen head screws pull the clamp halves together for a tight, non-slip hold. Also available with a 2" long, 4-slot, MIL-STD 1913 Picatinny rail that can be installed in the 3- or 9- o'clock position, for mounting additional accessories. Fits Remington 870, 1100, 11-87 and Benelli M1, M2, M4, M1014, 12 gauge shotguns.

Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON / BENELLI Tactical Barrel / Magazine Clamp

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the REMINGTON / BENELLI Tactical Barrel / Magazine Clamp from MESA TACTICAL PRODUCTS. This product is designed to securely hold your shotgun's barrel and extended magazine tube together while providing additional functionality, such as a tactical light mount. To ensure safe and effective use, please read and follow these safety instructions carefully.
