Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 25RD MAGAZINE 22LR

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AR15 25RD MAGAZINE 22LR. This magazine is designed for reliable performance with CMMG and similar Atchissontype .22 LR conversion systems. To ensure your safety and the safe use of this product, please read and follow the guidelines outlined in this document.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat the magazine as if it is loaded.
- Keep the magazine out of reach of children and unauthorized persons.
- Inspect the magazine regularly for any signs of damage or wear.
- Do not use the magazine if it is damaged or malfunctioning.

3. Removing the Magazine:

- Press the magazine release button on your firearm.
- Gently pull the magazine out of the magazine well.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance:

- To clean the magazine, remove the floorplate by pressing the release tab.
- Clean the interior and exterior of the magazine with a soft cloth.
- Reassemble the magazine by replacing the floorplate securely.

5. Disassembly:

- For complete disassembly, remove the six hexhead screws using an appropriate tool.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for reassembly after cleaning.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations.
- If the magazine is damaged beyond repair, it is recommended to recycle the polymer material where applicable.
