- To replace the batteries:
- Unscrew the battery cap.
- Remove old batteries and insert new ones, ensuring proper polarity.
- Replace and securely tighten the battery cap.

- Dispose of the TLR1 HL Weaponlight and its batteries in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of lithium batteries in regular household waste; use designated battery recycling programs.
