When mounted in accordance with BATF specifications for a permanent installation, this A2-pattern flash suppressor will bring a 14½" barrel up to a civilian-legal (non-NFA) 16.1" length. Comes with a pre-drilled hole and pin for permanently pinning to the barrel. Fits standard AR-15/M16 muzzle threads. Installation should be done by a qualified gunsmith familiar with BATF regulations.

AR15 Extended A2 Flash Suppressor Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AR15 Extended A2 Flash Suppressor. This product is designed to enhance your firearm's performance while ensuring compliance with safety regulations. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe installation and usage.
