When the added velocity of a longer barrel needs to be preserved, but the desire for additional weight reduction remains, barrel fluting serves as an excellent solution to help shave away unwanted bulk. Criterion fluted AR-15 barrels are designed to ensure maximum concentricity and consistent dimensions throughout the full length of the bore. Eight flutes are machined around the circumference of the barrel to the front and rear of the gas port. Each flute is polished to smooth jagged edges while retaining a sharp appearance. Each 416R stainless steel barrel comes complete with an M4 barrel extension and a .223 Wylde chamber designed to accept both .223 Remington and 5.56 NATO cartridges.

# Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 Fluted Stainless Steel Rifle Length Barrels

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Criterion Fluted AR15 Barrel. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe use and maintenance of your product. Please read this document carefully before installation and usage.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Always handle firearms with care and in accordance with local laws and regulations.
- Ensure that the barrel is compatible with your AR15 platform.

- Be aware of the barrel's twist rate (18) and its implications for bullet stability and performance.
- Use the barrel only with a compatible gas system length (Rifle) to avoid malfunctions.
- Regularly clean and maintain the barrel to ensure optimal performance and safety.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### • Installation:

1. Ensure your firearm is completely unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
2. Remove the existing barrel from the upper receiver of your AR15.
3. Install the Criterion fluted barrel by aligning it with the barrel extension and securing it with the appropriate torque specifications.
4. Ensure that the muzzle threads (1/228) are clean and free from debris before attaching any muzzle device.
5. Inspect the installation for any misalignment or improper seating.

### • Usage:

1. Load only the recommended ammunition: .223 Remington, 5.56 NATO, or .223 Wylde.
2. Perform a function check after installation to ensure proper cycling of the action.
3. Fire the firearm in a controlled environment, adhering to all safety protocols.
4. Monitor the barrel for any signs of overheating or excessive wear during use.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the barrel in accordance with local regulations regarding metal and firearm components.
- Do not dispose of the barrel with regular household waste.
- If the barrel is damaged beyond repair, consult with local waste management authorities for proper disposal.
