Flat top receiver with a full weaver rail . Forearm has a great futuristic and ergonomic design with a quad rail molded in to the top as well as a light attachment molded in to the front of the fore end. Chambered for both 2 3/4" and 3" shells.

Safety Instruction Guide for ARTWELVE 12 Gauge AR12

Introduction
