Safety Instruction Guide for the GALIL 5.56 FOLDING POLYMER 18"

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the GALIL 5.56 Folding Polymer rifle. This guide provides important safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe use of your firearm. Please read this manual carefully before operating the rifle.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat every firearm as if it is loaded.

- Do not attempt to fire the rifle if it is wet or has been submerged in water.
- If a round does not fire, wait at least 30 seconds before attempting to eject it.
- Always engage the safety mechanism when the rifle is not in use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation

1. Ensure the firearm is unloaded before beginning installation.
2. Attach the folding stock according to the manufacturer's instructions.
3. Verify that all components are securely fastened before use.

Usage

- To load the magazine, ensure the rifle is pointed in a safe direction.
- Insert the magazine into the magazine well until it clicks into place.
- Pull the charging handle to the rear to chamber a round.
- To fire, disengage the safety mechanism and pull the trigger.
- After firing, keep the rifle pointed downrange and remove the magazine.
- To unload, pull the charging handle to the rear and visually inspect the chamber to ensure it is empty.
