DELTA 5 PRO Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the DELTA 5 PRO 24" 10+1 in 6.5 Creedmoor. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe and effective use of your firearm. Please read this guide thoroughly before handling or using the DELTA 5 PRO.

General Safety Guidelines
