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Safety Instruction Guide for 1911 Government/Commander 8RD Magazine

Introduction

- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Firmly press the magazine into the well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine from the Firearm

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction and the safety is engaged.
- Press the magazine release button while simultaneously pulling the magazine out of the magazine well.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance

- Regularly clean the magazine to ensure optimal performance.
- Use a soft cloth to remove dirt and debris from the exterior.
- Inspect the follower and spring for any signs of wear or damage.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations regarding firearm accessories.
- If the magazine is damaged beyond repair, consider recycling metal components where applicable.
