A flat, K-style trigger with a textured face offers positive contact—a familiar feel to 1911 shooters, while its grip angle and contour draw their lineage directly to the proven CZ 75 known for its comfort and control. The DWX Compact utilizes the Ned Christiansen style frag pattern on the front, backstrap, and on the Henning aluminum grips for a comfortable shooting experience that provides traction. The grip's low-profile design naturally positions the shooter's hand high in the beavertail for optimum recoil control. CZ 75 Compact grip compatibility with the DWX allows customization with aftermarket options.

Safety Instruction Guide for DWX C 9mm Compact Pistol

Introduction
