

BROWNING A-BOLT LONG ACTION HD PICATINNY SCOPE MOUNT - EGW BROWNING A-BOLT LA 1-PIECE PICATINNY BASE 0 MOA

This mount comes standard with a bevel on both sides making it ambidextrous. EGW recommends measuring the hole spacing in your receiver to confirm it matches with the dimensions they have published. Picatinny cross slots run the full length of the rail, which gives the shooter flexibility when mounting scope rings and other accessories. EGW one-piece scope mounts are the obvious choice for hunters and tactical shooters alike. This mount is a Picatinny-style base and compatible with Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. EGW machines these in their shop using one of their machining centers. After machining, the mounts are tumbled, sand blasted, and Type III anodized for long lasting durability. Recommend: 0 MOA - if shooting 0-500 yards 20 MOA - if shooting 500-1000 yards When zeroing your rifle with a 20 MOA mount, EGW recommends zeroing at 200 yards. Installation: EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite (loctite is sold separately). The entire mount and accessories (from the mounting screws and wrench down to the packaging) are made in the USA. This mount fits: Browning A-Bolt Long Action Please check your screw diameter. Regular Browning A-Bolts come with #6 screws. Browning AB3s come with #8 screws. This product is designed for the standard A-Bolt, not the AB3. EGW does offer a mount for the AB3. The part number for that is 43400 for a 0 MOA and 43402 for a 20 MOA. EGW does not currently offer a Browning A-Bolt that will work for the Mountain Titanium in .300WSM.

Safety Instruction Guide for BROWNING ABOLT LONG ACTION HD PICATINNY SCOPE MOUNT

Introduction

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure the mount is compatible with your specific firearm model.

Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- Verify the screw diameter before installation:
 - Regular Browning ABolts use #6 screws.
 - Browning AB3s use #8 screws.
- This product is designed for the standard ABolt model only, not the AB3.
- Ensure the mount is securely fastened before use to prevent accidents.
- Use only recommended torque settings of 20 inch lbs for installation.
- Apply a drip of blue loctite to the screws to secure them in place (loctite sold separately).
- Always zero your rifle at the recommended distance based on the mount MOA:
 - 0 MOA for shooting 0500 yards.
 - 20 MOA for shooting 5001000 yards, with zeroing recommended at 200 yards.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation:

- Gather necessary tools, including a torque wrench and blue loctite.
- Ensure your workspace is clean and welllit.

2. Installation Steps:

- Check that the mounting holes on your receiver match the published dimensions.
- Align the mount with the mounting holes on the receiver.
- Insert the screws into the mounting holes, ensuring they fit correctly.
- Using a torque wrench, tighten the screws to 20 inch lbs.
- Apply a drip of blue loctite to each screw for added security.

3. PostInstallation Check:

- Verify that the mount is securely attached and does not wobble.
- Confirm that there are no obstructions preventing the scope from being mounted.

4. Usage:

- When mounting your scope, utilize the Picatinny cross slots for flexibility.
- Adjust the scope rings to your preferred positioning.
- Regularly check the mount and scope for any signs of loosening or damage during use.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the mount and packaging materials in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the mount in general waste if it is damaged or deemed unsafe.
- Recycle materials where possible.
