- Measure the O.D. of the barrel to ensure it is .702" (17.8mm).

- For Gunsmith Fit (G/F) installation:

- Measure the O.D. of the barrel to ensure it is .702" and the I.D. of the bushing is .574" (14.6mm).
- Professional fitting may be required to ensure optimal performance.

3. Usage:

- After installation, test the bushing by cycling the firearm to ensure smooth operation.

- Regularly clean and maintain the bushing and firearm to ensure longevity and performance.

Disposal Instructions
