Safety Instruction Guide for SCRAPERS JERRY FISHER LARGE FISHER SCRAPER

Introduction

- After use, clean the scraper to remove any wood shavings or debris.

- Regularly check the cutting heads for sharpness and damage.
- Sharpen the edges as necessary, following the manufacturer's guidelines.
- Store the scraper in a dry environment to prevent rust and deterioration.
