SIG SAUER P320 Magazines Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SIG SAUER 320 Magazine, designed for the SIG SAUER P320 in 9mm caliber. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe and effective use of your magazine. Please read this document carefully before using the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the magazine is compatible with your firearm model (SIG SAUER P320) to avoid malfunctions.
- Always treat the magazine as if it is loaded, even when you believe it is empty.
- Store magazines in a secure location, out of reach of children and unauthorized users.

- Use only 9mm Luger ammunition in this magazine.

- When loading or unloading the magazine, keep your fingers clear of the magazine's feed lips to prevent injury.
- Do not attempt to modify or disassemble the magazine beyond the easy disassembly feature provided by the base plate.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Loading the Magazine:

- Ensure the magazine is clean and free of debris.
- Hold the magazine with the feed lips facing upwards.
- Insert the first round into the magazine, pushing it down until it clicks into place.
- Continue adding rounds one at a time until you reach the maximum capacity of 17 rounds.
- For best performance, avoid using excessive force when loading.

2. Inserting the Magazine into the Firearm:

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction and the safety is engaged.
- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Firmly push the magazine into the well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine:

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction and the safety is engaged.
- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Gently pull the magazine out of the magazine well.

4. Disassembly for Cleaning:

- Ensure the magazine is empty before disassembly.

- Locate the specially designed base plate and press the release mechanism.
- Slide the base plate off to access the internal components for cleaning.
- Clean the magazine with a soft cloth and avoid using harsh chemicals.
