Fits Chinese, Yugoslavian, Albanian, Romanian, and post 1950 Russian SKS rifles. Not for use in pre-1951 Russian models with shallower firing pin hole. Includes spare firing pin spring and instructions.

SKS Enhanced Firing Pin Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SKS Enhanced Firing Pin from MURRAYS. This product is designed to improve the safety and reliability of your SKS rifle. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure proper use and maintenance of the firing pin.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the firing pin is compatible with your specific SKS model. This product is designed for post1950 Russian SKS rifles and clones.
