It also comes with a large heavy weight brass obstruction remover and a slotted tip. It comes complete with brass scraper components such as the brass scraper, female rod handle, a receiver brush, and a .50 caliber end brush, all of which allow for precision cleaning in those hard to reach areas of your firearms. Other components include 3-inch panoply patches, .50 caliber chamber brush and bore brush, bore reflector/flag safety, and the all-in-one Otis O85 Ultra Bore Solvent. The .50 caliber gear has a thread size of 10/32.

Introduction

- Insert the patch into the slotted tip.

4. Cleaning the Bore:

- Insert the cleaning rod into the barrel from the chamber end (where applicable).
- Gently push the rod through the bore and pull it back out.
- Repeat this process several times using clean patches until the bore is clean.

5. Using the Brushes:

- Use the .50 caliber chamber brush and bore brush for thorough cleaning.
- Attach the brushes to the cleaning rod as needed and clean the chamber and bore.

6. Final Inspection:

- Inspect the bore and chamber for cleanliness.
- Use the brass scraper components for any stubborn fouling if necessary.

• PostCleaning:

- Store all components in a safe place.
- Ensure that the cleaning area is clean and free of any hazardous materials.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used patches and any cleaning materials according to local regulations.
