Easily strip copper and lead from bores using the included 3-inch 100-percent cotton, all caliber patches and heavy-duty bore brush. This pistol cleaning system comes with a .20 caliber & a .30 caliber solid brass slotted tip, a .20 caliber & a .30 caliber obstruction remover; which can be used to clean obstructions out of the bore, a t-handle for added comfort while pulling the flexible rod through the barrel, and a bore reflector/flag safety. Comes complete with a .5oz. tube of Otis O85 Ultra Bore Solvent, and the .38 and .45 caliber bore brushes. All components are neatly packed in a .5lb., pocket size, softpack case complete with a belt loop attachment and a locking zipper.

610 Cleaning System Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the 610 Cleaning System, designed specifically for cleaning .22 caliber through .45 caliber pistols. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe and effective use of the product. Please read this guide carefully before using the cleaning system.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation:

- Gather all components of the 610 Cleaning System, including the rod, brushes, patches, and solvent.

2. Cleaning Process:

- Attach the appropriate slotted tip to the cleaning rod based on the caliber of your firearm.
- Moisten a cotton patch with the Otis O85 Ultra Bore Solvent and insert it into the slotted tip.
- Insert the cleaning rod into the bore from the breech end and gently pull it through to the muzzle end.
- Repeat the process with a clean patch until the bore is free of fouling.
- Use the heavyduty bore brush to scrub the bore for stubborn deposits. Follow the same breech to muzzle cleaning technique.
- Clean any obstructions using the obstruction remover provided. Insert it carefully into the bore and remove any blockages.

3. PostCleaning:

- After cleaning, ensure the firearm is dry and free of cleaning solvents before reassembling.
- Store the cleaning system in the provided softpack case, ensuring all components are securely placed.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used patches and any cleaning materials in accordance with local regulations for hazardous waste.
- Do not dispose of cleaning solvents down the drain or in regular household trash. Follow local disposal guidelines for chemicals.
