PPC and BR cases with .060 inch flash holes are accommodated by simply inserting the included undersized decap pin. An optional decap rod assembly is available for 17 and 20 caliber cases. The die is shipped with three headed decap pins for standard .080 inch flash holes, two pins for .060 inch flash holes and our new stainless steel Sinclair Lock Ring. Decap pins are standard Hornady headed pins.
