This large caliber tool uses the same cutter adjustment system as our NT-1000 Neck Turner, and each cutter is hand stoned high-speed tool steel for the best possible cut finish. A Large Caliber Case Handle is furnished with each NT-5000 tool. Special large caliber Expander Dies (available for 7/8 inches -14 presses and one and half inch - 12 presses), and large caliber turning and expander mandrels are available individually or as part of a Large Caliber Neck Turning Tool Kit.
