Safety Instruction Guide for TRIM PRO 2 POWER CASE TRIMMER

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the TRIM PRO 2 POWER CASE TRIMMER. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure safe and effective use of the product. Please read this manual carefully before using the trimmer to understand its features and safety precautions.

2. Setting Up the Trimmer:

- Place the trimmer on a stable work surface.
- Ensure the power switch is in the "off" position before plugging it in.
- Connect the trimmer to a suitable power outlet (110V).

3. Adjusting the Trim Length:

- Use the manual on/off switch to set the desired case trim length.
- Refer to the pilot size guide to select the appropriate pilot for your case size.

4. Operating the Trimmer:

- Turn on the trimmer using the integral power switch.
- Insert the case into the universal shell holder.

- Allow the selffeeding springfed cutter to trim the case without applying pressure.
- Use your hands for other preparation tasks while the trimmer operates.

5. Finishing Up:

- Once trimming is complete, turn off the trimmer and unplug it from the outlet.
- Clean any debris from the trimmer and surrounding area.
