The Redding 6.5x47mm Lapua Competition Bushing Neck Sizer Die is similar in concept to the Competition Seating Die, the cartridge case is completely supported and aligned with the sizing bushing before the sizing process begins. As the sizing process starts, the cartridge case remains supported in the tightly chambered, sliding sleeve as it moves upward. The resizing bushing self-centers on the case neck. The decapping rod is maintained in precise alignment by using the internal parts of the die as a linear support much like that of a firing pin. Meanwhile, the micrometer adjustment of the bushing position delivers precise control to the desired amount of neck length to be sized. Bushings and shellholders sold separately. Made in the USA.

# Safety Instruction Guide for the Redding 6.5x47mm Lapua Competition Bushing Neck Die

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Redding 6.5x47mm Lapua Competition Bushing Neck Die. This product is designed for precision reloading of ammunition.   - The decapping rod will align automatically during the resizing process.

- Ensure that the primer pocket is clear and free from debris after decapping.

#### 4. Adjusting Neck Length:

- Use the micrometer adjustment to set the desired neck length before resizing.
- Make small adjustments and test the fit of the resized case in the chamber.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn parts of the die in accordance with local waste disposal regulations.
- Do not dispose of the die in regular household trash if it is contaminated with hazardous materials.
