# Safety Instruction Guide for 1911 Extended Thumb Safety

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the 1911 Extended Thumb Safety. This product is designed to enhance your shooting experience while ensuring your safety. Please read this guide carefully to understand how to use, install, and dispose of the product safely.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat your firearm as if it is loaded.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Installation

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Remove the old thumb safety if applicable, following the manufacturer's guidelines.
- Align the new 1911 Extended Thumb Safety with the safety hole on the frame of your firearm.
- Carefully insert the safety pin and ensure it is seated properly.
- Test the thumb safety by engaging and disengaging it multiple times to ensure proper function.

### 2. Usage

- To engage the thumb safety, push the lever down until it clicks into place.
- To disengage the thumb safety, push the lever up with your thumb.
- Maintain a natural and sweeping motion when using the thumb safety to ensure a comfortable grip.
- Regularly check the thumb pad for wear; it should measure .976" (24.8mm) long and .223" (5.6mm) wide.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations.
- If the product is damaged or no longer usable, ensure it is disposed of safely to prevent accidents.

- Do not discard in regular household waste; consider recycling options if available.
