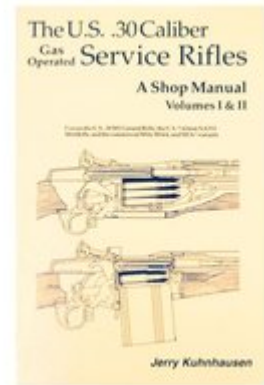

Introduction
