Safety Instructions for Tipton Solid Brass Jag 30 / 32 Caliber

Introduction

- Ensure it is securely attached before use.

3. Prepare for Cleaning:

- Soak the cleaning patch with an appropriate solvent.
- Place the patch over the jag.

4. Insert the Jag:

- Carefully insert the jag into the bore of the firearm.
- Ensure that the pointed tip keeps the patch centered.

5. Clean the Bore:

- Gently pull the cleaning rod back and forth to clean the bore.
- Avoid using excessive force; let the jag do the work.

6. Remove the Jag:

- After cleaning, carefully remove the jag from the bore.
- Dispose of the used cleaning patch properly.
