Tipton Solid Brass Slotted Tip Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Tipton Solid Brass Slotted Tip for your firearm cleaning needs. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe and effective use of this product. Please read all instructions carefully before use.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that you are following all local laws and regulations regarding firearm cleaning and maintenance.

- Gather all necessary materials: Slotted Tip, patches, solvent or oil, and a cleaning rod.

2. Installation:

- Attach the Slotted Tip to the cleaning rod by screwing it onto the threaded end (832 for Rifle/Pistol Tips).
- Ensure it is securely tightened to prevent detachment during use.

3. Usage:

- For flooding the barrel with solvent:
 - Secure a patch in the Slotted Tip.
 - Dip the patch in the solvent and insert it into the barrel.
 - Gently push the rod back and forth to ensure the solvent saturates the bore.
- For wiping the bore with oil or preservatives:
 - Repeat the above steps using a patch soaked in oil or preservative.
 - Ensure to cover the entire length of the bore.

4. After Use:

- Clean the Slotted Tip with a suitable solvent to remove any residue.
- Store the Slotted Tip in a dry place away from direct sunlight and moisture.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used patches and solvents according to local regulations for hazardous waste.
- Do not dispose of the Slotted Tip in regular household waste if it is damaged. Check with local disposal services for proper guidelines.
