Introduction

- After cleaning, inspect the barrel to ensure it is free from debris.
- Store the cleaning pellets in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and moisture.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used felt cleaning pellets and any cleaning materials in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of cleaning pellets in regular household waste if they contain hazardous materials.
