The ACC (Adjustable Core Competition) Chassis was created with an integrated weight management system, allowing shooters to fine tune the weight and balance point of the rifle. The adjustability comes from a series of weights that can be added to either the buttstock, interior forend or exterior forend. Its original weight of 2,7 kg transforms into a maximum of 5,6 kg (chassis only - add on your action, barrel, scope and accessories and most shooters are pushing 12-14 kg in the ACC).

MDT ACC Chassis System Kit Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MDT ACC Chassis System Kit for your Tikka T3, T3x, T1x rifle. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use and maintenance of your chassis system. Please read this guide carefully before installation and usage to maximize safety and performance.

- If using the rifle in a competition or public area, be mindful of your surroundings and ensure the rifle is pointed in a safe direction at all times.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

- Remove the original stock from the rifle following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Align the rifle action with the MDT ACC Chassis and secure it using the provided screws.
