The underside of the rails are profiled to allow the rail to be mounted flush on the receiver and to match the geometry of the ejection port. These rails are designed with a 20 MOA incline providing additional elevation adjustment from your scope. A recoil lug has been integrated in the underside rail profile on models where the action's design allows for this feature. MDT's ESS Scope Base Picatinny Rails are specifically designed to be used with our ESS chassis system. The rails height has been determined to specifically align with the full & partial rail ESS forend.
