- Ambidextrous, easy reach magazine latch - can be operated with trigger finger or left hand.
- Barricade stop in front of the magazine to prevent putting pressure on the magazine.
- Compatible with all non-beavertail AR pattern pistol grips. Beavertail grips will fit with minor trimming.

MDT ESS Chassis System Kit Safety Instructions

Introduction

- To adjust the height of the cheek rest, turn the thumb wheel located on the cheek rest itself.

- Insert the magazine into the well, ensuring it clicks into place securely.
- To remove the magazine, press the ambidextrous magazine latch using your trigger finger or left hand.
