- V-block bedding system to form a solid and reliable base for the rifle action.
- The magazine well has been refined for easy insertion of the magazine.
- Ambidextrous, easy reach magazine latch - can be operated with trigger finger or left hand.
- Barricade stop in front of the magazine to prevent putting pressure on the magazine.
- Compatible with all non-beavertail AR pattern pistol grips. Beavertail grips will fit with minor trimming.

Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation of the Chassis System:

- Ensure the rifle is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Remove the existing stock from the Tikka T3/T3x rifle.
- Align the rifle action with the Vblock bedding system in the chassis.
- Secure the action using the provided screws, ensuring a tight fit.
- Install the adjustable buttstock and ensure it is locked in place.
- Attach the AR pistol grip, ensuring it is compatible with the chassis system.

2. Adjusting the Buttstock and Cheek Rest:

- Use the thumb wheels to adjust the height of the cheek rest and the length of the buttpad.
- Ensure adjustments are made while the rifle is in a safe position.

3. Using the Magazine:

- Insert the magazine into the well until it clicks into place.
- Ensure the magazine latch is functioning correctly for easy removal.
