- V-block bedding system to form a solid and reliable base for the rifle action.
- The magazine well has been refined for easy insertion of the magazine.
- Ambidextrous, easy reach magazine latch - can be operated with trigger finger or left hand.
- Barricade stop in front of the magazine to prevent putting pressure on the magazine.
- Compatible with all non-beavertail AR pattern pistol grips. Beavertail grips will fit with minor trimming.

- Adjust the cheek rest height similarly by using the thumb wheels for a comfortable cheek weld.

- Insert the magazine into the magazine well until it clicks into place.
- To remove the magazine, press the ambidextrous magazine latch with your trigger finger or left hand.
