- V-block bedding system to form a solid and reliable base for the rifle action.
- The magazine well has been refined for easy insertion of the magazine.
- Ambidextrous, easy reach magazine latch – can be operated with trigger finger or left hand.
- Barricade stop in front of the magazine to prevent putting pressure on the magazine.
- Compatible with all non-beavertail AR pattern pistol grips. Beavertail grips will fit with minor trimming.

Introduction

- The ambidextrous magazine latch can be operated with the trigger finger or left hand for easy access.

- Verify that all adjustments are secure and that the chassis system is functioning properly.
