The ACC (Adjustable Core Competition) Chassis was created with an integrated weight management system, allowing shooters to fine tune the weight and balance point of the rifle. The adjustability comes from a series of weights that can be added to either the buttstock, interior forend or exterior forend. Its original weight of 2,7 kg transforms into a maximum of 5,6 kg (chassis only - add on your action, barrel, scope and accessories and most shooters are pushing 12-14 kg in the ACC).

MDT ACC Chassis System Kit Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MDT ACC Chassis System Kit for your CZ 455, 457 rifle. This guide provides important safety information, installation instructions, and usage precautions to ensure your safety and the proper functioning of your product. - If you experience any malfunctions or unusual behavior from the chassis system, cease use immediately and consult a qualified gunsmith or the manufacturer.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation of Weights:

- Identify the desired location for weight adjustment (buttstock, interior forend, or exterior forend).
- Ensure the rifle is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Loosen the retention screws using the appropriate tool.
- Add or remove weights as necessary to achieve the desired balance.
- Secure the weights by tightening the retention screws firmly but do not overtighten.

2. Mounting Accessories:

- Utilize the 17" ARCA/RRS dovetail for mounting accessories.
- Ensure that all accessories are compatible with the dovetail system.
- Tighten retention screws on accessories to prevent them from loosening during use.

3. Using the MDT Elite Grip:

- Ensure the grip is securely attached to the chassis system.
- Adjust the grip position if necessary for comfort and control.
