The ACC (Adjustable Core Competition) Chassis was created with an integrated weight management system, allowing shooters to fine tune the weight and balance point of the rifle. The adjustability comes from a series of weights that can be added to either the buttstock, interior forend or exterior forend. Its original weight of 2,7 kg transforms into a maximum of 5,6 kg (chassis only - add on your action, barrel, scope and accessories and most shooters are pushing 12-14 kg in the ACC).

- Remove the original stock from the Remington 700.
- Carefully attach the MDT ACC Chassis to the action of the rifle, ensuring a secure fit.
- Utilize the MDT's proprietary XTN buttstock interface to attach the adjustable stock included with your chassis.

- Add or remove weights from the buttstock, interior forend, or exterior forend as needed to achieve your desired balance.
