The guide sleeve has the internal contour of the cartridge chamber to cover the cartridge case.

The guide sleeve and the body of this reloading-die are perfectly matched to ensure exact axial alignment of the cartridge during the sizing process.

TRIEBEL BenchRest Neck Die Safety Instructions

Introduction
