The precision aluminum V-block bedding system ensures fit and function to maximize the accuracy of any rifle action. The XRS Chassis features a replaceable over molded and textured grip system, with both an angled grip and a vertical grip included in box.

The XRS Chassis is the most advanced and configurable crossover stock on the market and is the ideal performance upgrade for any factory rifle or foundation for a custom rifle build. Weighing in at 1,7kg (depending on inlet), the XRS is ideal for both hunting or target rifles. The XRS features adjustable length of pull via spacers from 13.25" to 15+" and a quick adjust cheek piece to adjust for scope height over bore. The XRS accepts standard AICS pattern magazines and has an easy to manipulate ambidextrous magazine latch. The generous 12" long Forend comes with M-LOK slots built in for accessory mounting and attachment of ARCA or picatinny rails.

MDT XRS TIKKA T3 LH Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MDT XRS TIKKA T3 LH Chassis System. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines for the safe use, installation, and disposal of your product. Please read this guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use.

- Use only compatible AICS pattern magazines with the chassis.

- Ensure that the cheek piece is correctly adjusted to avoid discomfort or injury during use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation of the Chassis:

- Carefully remove the chassis from its packaging.
- Ensure all components are present: chassis, grips, and any included accessories.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for installing the rifle action into the chassis.
- Secure the action with the precision aluminum Vblock bedding system.

2. Adjusting the Chassis:

- Adjust the length of pull using the spacers provided. The range is from 13.25" to 15+".
- Adjust the cheek piece to the desired height for optimal scope alignment.

3. Using the Chassis:

- Load the rifle with a compatible AICS pattern magazine ensuring it is seated properly.
- Familiarize yourself with the ambidextrous magazine latch for easy manipulation.
- Use the MLOK slots on the forend for attaching accessories as needed.
- Always ensure that the rifle is pointed in a safe direction when loading and unloading.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the chassis and its components in accordance with local regulations for the disposal of metal and plastic materials.
- Do not dispose of the chassis in regular household waste. Instead, take it to a designated recycling facility.
- Ensure that all components are free of any firearmrelated materials before disposal.
