Safety Instruction Guide for AR500 Target AR500 33% Deer Target

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Caldwell's Game Series AR500 Steel Targets. This guide provides important safety instructions and guidelines to ensure a safe and enjoyable shooting experience. Please read this document carefully before using the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat every firearm as if it is loaded.
- Ensure that you are in a safe shooting environment, away from people and property.
- Use appropriate eye and ear protection when shooting.
- Familiarize yourself with your firearm and its operation before using it with the targets.
- Inspect the target and mounting equipment before each use for signs of damage.
- Only use the AR500 targets with centerfire rifles that are within the specified impact velocities and energy limits.

- Do not shoot at the target from distances closer than recommended. Maintain a minimum distance of 100 yards for highvelocity rounds.
- Ensure that the target is securely mounted before shooting.
- Avoid shooting at the target with ammunition that exceeds the specified impact energy of 3,500 ftlb.
- Be aware of ricochet risks; ensure a proper backstop is in place.
- Do not use the targets in adverse weather conditions that may affect safety or visibility.
- Supervise inexperienced shooters, ensuring they understand safety protocols.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation

1. **Select a Suitable Location:** Choose a location that is safe and has a clear line of sight, away from people and property.
2. **Prepare the Mounting Equipment:** Use the Caldwell AR500 Target Post for secure mounting.
3. **Attach the Target:**
 - Align the target's 1/2" x 1" center slot with the target post.
 - Secure the target firmly to the post, ensuring it is stable and will not fall during use.
4. **Check Stability:** Before shooting, ensure that the target is securely fastened and does not wobble.

Usage

1. **Load Your Firearm Safely:** Follow all firearm safety protocols while loading your weapon.
2. **Position Yourself:** Stand at a safe distance (minimum of 100 yards) from the target.
